 - a. What are the 3 "of first importance" proclamations of the gospel and who is central to each of them? See verses 3-4
 - b. What is the condition for being saved by this gospel according to verse 2?
 - c. What testimonies did Paul base his confidence in the truth of the gospel according to verses: 3b, 4b, 5-8? Refer also to Isaiah 53: 5, 9, 11-12. Why are those testimonials so important?
- 3. Why is the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, at the core of Christianity and what are the consequences of denying it according to the following verses?
 - a. Verse 14, 17a Give examples of 'futile' faith and what it looks like or is based on?
 - b. Verse 15. How would this tarnish the character of the disciples and of Jesus? See Matthew 16:21
 - c. Verse 17b. What are the consequences of sin according to Romans 6:23?
 - d. Verse 18. What hope or comfort do we have in the death of believers?
 - e. Verse 19. What basis for joy is there to have? See Luke 10:20
- 4. According to Romans 4:25, Christ was raised for our justification:
 - a. What does justification mean? How can you explain it to a non-believer?
 - b. What blessings does justification bring with it according to Romans 5:1,2,9-11? List the things which are now ours to enjoy. What should be our response to those blessings?
- 5. How did God raise the Lord Jesus from death? See 1 Corinthians 6:14. What does Paul pray in Philippians 3:10a? What difference do those verses make to our daily struggles with sin, mistreatment, sickness and other hardships? See also 1 Corinthians 15:57
