3. Read Hebrews 11:11-12. Sarah laughed at God. Why is Sarah included in the "Hall of Faith"?
4. Read Genesis 22:1-10. God asks a most difficult task of Abraham. How does Abraham respond? What about walking by faith is implied in this passage?
5. Read Daniel 6:7-10, 16-23. How does this passage reveal Daniel's faith?
6. Read Luke 17:5-6. What do the disciples ask Jesus for? How does Jesus respond to their question?
7. Read James 2:14-26.
 - a. What does dead faith look like?
 - b. What does useless faith look like?
8. Does James 2:18 contradict Paul in Romans 3:28 when he writes "man is saved by faith without the works of the law"?
9. Read Ephesians 2:8-10. What are the three steps that bring us to works?

Look Out

10. There is a group of Christians who live in a particular community. What might some of the evidence be that there are Christians in the neighbourhood?

Look In

11. What has God been asking of you that you have shied away from?
12. What is the biggest stumbling block to you taking that step of faith?
