5. Read Matthew 17:20, Mark 9:29. The disciples could not cast out the demon from the man's son. Why? What two things were lacking?
6. Read Gen 11:6 Pastor Oscar outlined this for us in today's message. What were the important principles he pulled from this passage?
7. What different components of unity are required in order to make the impossible happen?
8. Read Acts 4:29. Where else in Scripture do you see prayers for boldness. What is the result of those prayers?
9. What is the role of prayer in the life of the disciples?

10. How does the way we live impact how others see Jesus?
11. What principle does the man not giving up lay out for us today as we look at the world around us?

12. As you reflect on Pastor Oscar's message, answer the following questions:
 - a. In whom or in what are you currently placing your faith?
