The Passover meal sets the stage for this unveiling ...

- Passover preparation reveals Jesus is in control. Luke 22:7-13
- At this meal Jesus reveals His heart for us.
 Luke 22:14-16; Hebrews 12:2; Revelation 19:6-9; 1 Corinthians 11:26
- Jesus emphasizes the communion we have with Him and each other.

Luke 22:17-18

- Broken bread is a symbol of His afflicted body. Luke 22:19; Deuteronomy 16:3
- The cup is a symbol of His shed blood. Luke 22:20; Exodus 24:5-8

Jeremiah 31:34 prophesied about this New Covenant. It is superior to the Old Covenant...

Personal Knowledge not vague awareness	Luke 22:34a
