To be empowered by the Spirit we have to be steered by the Spirit. Think of it like riding a bicycle. Deciding to follow Jesus is like mounting a bike and starting to peddle. Then as we follow Him, as we ride, the Spirit steers us. He prompts us to turn this way and that way. He prompts us to stop and pray ... to go faster and not be afraid ... to slow down and listen.

You stay on the bike and peddle with the strength He provides and then let the Spirit steer you. He knows where to go!

↪ Immediately **obey** the Spirit's prompting.

↪ Prepare to **share** the Good News of Jesus.

Acts 8:30-38

↪ Be ready to **repeat it**.

Acts 8:39-40

1. Live in **true submission** to the Spirit.
2. Immerse yourself in **God's Word**.
