Realize the New Covenant gives us **hope!**

- **Betrayal** Luke 22:21-23
- **Prideful Dissension** Luke 22:24-30
- **Denial and Failure** Luke 22:31-34
- **Misperception** Luke 22:35-38

We are as self-centered, presumptuous, dense, and sinful as the disciples. Is there any hope for us? Yes, there is -- because of the New Covenant!

Isaiah 53:12 teaches us that Jesus:

- **Identified** with us.
- **Paid** for our sin.
- **Intercedes** for us.
