In the first commandment we are told to worship the right God and the second commandment has to do with worshipping the right God the right way. It forbids us to worship the true God falsely. How we worship is as important as Whom we worship. Ask yourself: "Am I keeping the Second Commandment?"

Four parts to the Second Commandment:

- The Rule Don't make any idols. Exodus 20:4
- The Reason Because of His jealousy. Exodus 20:5a
- The Warning Children will be punished for fathers' sin. Exodus 20:5b
- The Promise Eternal blessing follows those who obey. Exodus 20:6

Case Study - Paul and the Philosophers of AthensActs 17:16-34Athens was full of idols.God cannot be squeezed into some man-made idol.

What are ways we make idols today?

- When we worship an image rather than listening to God's Word.
- When we turn God into something we can manipulate.
- When we only worship some of His attributes.

How can we worship the right God the right way?

Rather than re-making God into our image, realize we are to be re-made in His image.

Jesus does this in us through the power of the Holy Spirit.
