Proverbs 22:1

- 1. Is that I'm about to say true?
- 2. Is so, does it really need to be said now to this person?
- 3. Would I put it this way if that person were here right now?

It is just as wrong to listen to gossip.

Proverbs 18:18

What can you do when someone tries to gossip to you?

- 1. Interrupt them.
- 2. Offer to pray instead.
- 3. Re-direct the conversation.

If lying is wrong, then what is required?
