your Resurrection!

In response to a complicated question, Jesus affirms:

- **Not all** are resurrected to glory. Luke 20:35
- Those resurrected will **never taste death** again. Luke 20:36a
- Those resurrected will be **like the angels**. Luke 20:36b
- Resurrection means **living forever**. Luke 20:37-38
