One Step Behind Jesus: The Last Supper – Part 2
Luke 22:21-38

As the Last Supper concluded, some tragic realities unfolded.
The disciples were struggling to apply what Jesus had just said to them.
His profound promises were being overshadowed by their shortsightedness.
Though it crushed Him, He remained undeterred...

- Tell us about a time when the thing you hoped for did NOT come to pass.

Opening Questions

- Is there anything from Sunday's sermon that really stood out, made an impression, challenged or confused you?
- What is the New Covenant exactly (Jeremiah 31:33-34)?
- How is it different from the Old (Hebrews 10:11)?
- How did Jesus' life and death factor into the New Covenant happening?
- What do you think Jesus was feeling after this Last Supper when dissension and betrayal occurred?
- What is so hard about being "one who serves"?
- What was Jesus' greatest act of service toward us (1 Peter 2:24)?
- Read Isaiah 53:12. Which piece of this prophecy is most encouraging to you?

Read Luke 22:21-38

- Describe the contrast Jesus was wanting the disciples to grasp between rulers of the world and leaders of His kingdom (v.24-27).
- What blessing is Jesus giving in verses 28-30?
- Is Jesus giving a packing list or saying something else in verses 35-37 (Isaiah 53:12)?
- Why did Jesus respond with such frustration in verse 38?

Application

- Meditate on the New Covenant for a moment.
Thank Jesus for one particular aspect of it that stands out most in your mind.
- Are you leading (in your home, workplace, church, etc.) like the Gentiles or like Jesus?
What can you do to start serving like Him?
