One Step Behind Jesus: What Just Happened?
Luke 23:50-24:12

“What just happened?” This had to be the question on the mind of every follower of Jesus. They had watched Him suffer and then expire. It was over. These horrible events cascaded over them and snuffed out any and all hope. All that was left now was to bury the tortured body of their leader. When He died, all hope died with Him. Jesus had told them differently, but they did not believe His Word.
Do you believe His Word?

Opening Questions


- Is there anything from Sunday's sermon that really stood out, made an impression, challenged or confused you?

- What is the “kingdom of God” that Joseph was looking for in verse 52?
- What is the “day of preparation” in verse 54?
- Why do you think the disciples did not believe the women's reporting in verse 11?
- Why do you think Peter would have been the 1st to get to the tomb in verse 12?
