- How does 1 Corinthians 2:11 show the Holy Spirit has INTELLECT?
- How does Ephesians 4:30 show the Holy Spirit has EMOTION?
- How do we see exercise of WILL from the Holy Spirit in 1 Corinthians 12:11?
- Read these passages and discuss how they reveal to us that the Holy Spirit is God:

Acts 5:3-4, 2 Corinthians 3:17

Matthew 28:19, Luke 3:21-22, 2 Corinthians 13:14

Genesis 1:1-2, John 3:5-7, Romans 8:11, Matthew 12:28, 1 Corinthians 12:9

Psalms 139:7-8, 2 Corinthians 2:10-11, 1 Peter 3:13

What does it mean that we are baptized with the Holy Spirit at salvation?
